For **Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander University Students**

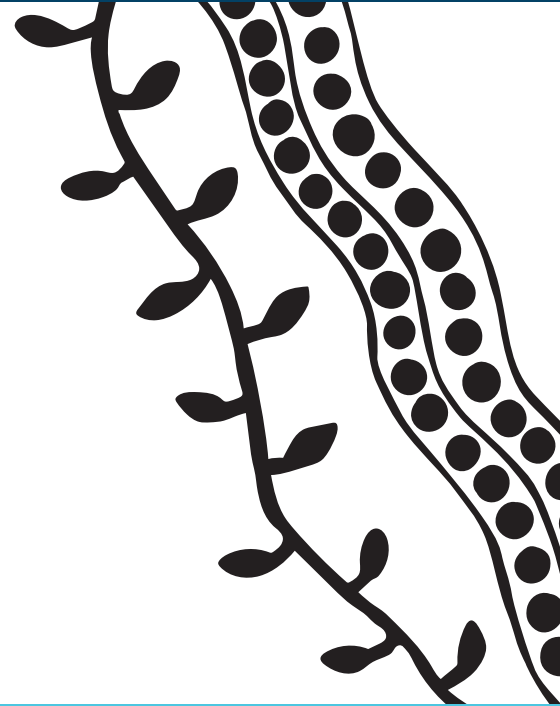
Teaching can make a real difference in the lives of others. You have the opportunity to become part of a profession that will shape the future for generations to come.

The scholarship provides financial assistance to support you in successfully completing your studies and progressing into employment at a BCE school/college.

- guidance and support navigating your educational and career path.



Scholarship Benefits

- up to \$5,000 HECS support each remaining year of teacher training (maximum \$20,000)
- a teaching position at a BCE school/college.

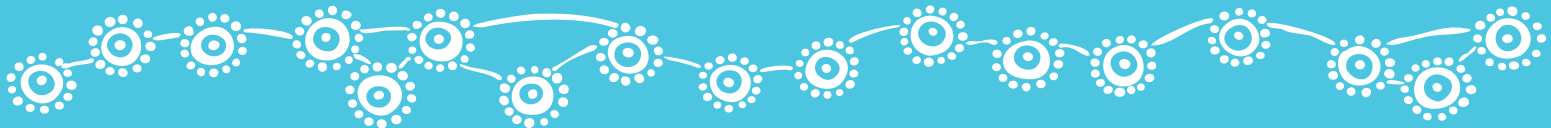
Scholarship Criteria
