For Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Year 12 Students


Teaching can make a real difference in the lives of others. You have the opportunity to become part of a profession that will shape the future for generations to come..

The scholarship provides financial assistance to support you in successfully completing your studies and progressing into employment at a BCE school/college.

A scholarship in teaching with Brisbane Catholic Education can provide:

- · connection to a supportive and inclusive community
- guidance and support navigating your educational and career path.



Scholarship Benefits

- up to \$5,000 HECS support each year of teacher training (maximum \$20,000)
- financial assistance in the first year of university study (maximum \$2,000) for initial study costs
- a teaching position at a BCE school/college.

Scholarship Criteria

- identify as of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- · completing Year 12 in 2025
- intend to apply for a teaching degree.
